UNEXPIRED TERM FULFILLMENT

When a vacancy occurs on the Board for a reason allowed by law, the remaining Board members are responsible for the appointment of a new Board member. The Board president will establish procedures for identifying a replacement to complete the vacated term.

The new appointee will qualify as if elected, at or before the next School Board meeting. He/She will serve until the next succeeding election, at which time a successor will be elected to serve the unexpired term.

UNEXPIRED TERM FULFILLMENT

Procedure

Appointments to unexpired terms will be made by the Board as follows:

- 1. An announcement of the vacancy will be published in the official newspaper.
- 2. The announcement will invite individuals to submit applications or nominations to the Board by a date set by the Board. An application form may be obtained at the school business office.
- 3. The Board will meet in executive session to discuss qualifications, interests, attitudes, and goals of the potential candidate.
- 4. The Board will interview potential appointees in executive session.
- 5. The appointment of the new member will be made by a majority of the board members at an open meeting.
- 6. Action on the appointment will be included on the published agenda for the meeting.
