

OPEN ENROLLMENT POLICY

This policy is enacted to fairly allow admission and assignment of both resident and non-resident students in the Pierre School District. For the purposes of this policy, the term “resident district” means the district in which a student has legal residence as determined by SDCL 13-28-9. The term “non-resident district” means any district in which a non-resident student seeks to enroll. The term “assigned school” means the attendance center within the district to which a resident student is assigned. The term “non-assigned school” means an attendance center within a resident student’s district to which the student has not been assigned.

The Board will accept all students from other districts wishing to enroll, provided the non-resident district’s facilities can accommodate the students without adversely affecting the quality of the educational program.
