ACCESSIBILITY CONTINGENCY PLAN

In an effort to insure that programs are accessible to all regardless of disabling conditions, every effort will be made to move programs to an accessible location. When this is not feasible, building, program, and equipment modifications will be made to fit the needs of the individual.

These modifications will take place before a known disabled individual enters the program or begins employment.

Some modifications the district could make to meet the needs of disable individuals are:

- 1. Ramps inside and outside buildings for individuals confined to a wheelchair.
- 2. Designated disabled parking.
- 3. Entrance doors to building, classrooms, and other areas where the disabled may be expected to require access.
- 4. Equal toilet facilities for the disabled.
- 5. Audible and visual signals for fire alarm systems.
- 6. Adaptive equipment to meet the needs of the disabled.
- 7. Deaf interpreters.
- 8. Other modifications, depending on the disabling conditions
